PAGE 4 - ISSUE: FEEL SAFE

1. HOLD WEEKLY POLICE SURGERIES AWAY FROM THE STATION, VENUE TO BE FIXED – ***SURGERIES WERE HELD AT WYTHALL LIBRARY FOR TWELVE MONTHS BUT CEASED AS NO MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WERE ATTENDING***
2. OPEN UP THE FRONT DESK AT THE POLICE STATION, STAFFING IT WITH VOLUNTEERS – ***THIS HAS NOT HAPPENED, MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC CAN ONLY SEE A POLICE OFFICE BY PRE ARRANGED APPOINTMENTS ONLY.***
3. ALTER WYTHALL POLICE STATION, WITH A NEW ENTRANCE, WITH DISABLED ACCESS AND FACILITIES – ***STARTS 2009***
4. OPEN THE POLICE STATION TO THE PUBLIC/WITH COMMUNITY PARTNERS HAVING AN OFFICE THEY COULD USE THERE – ***TALKS ONGOING***
5. WORK WITH COMMUNITY PARTNERS TO DEVELOP FACILITIES FOR THE YOUTH – ***MUGA AT WYTHALL PARK***
6. DATA COLLECTING – ***DONE***
7. EDUCATION RE SPEEDING - ***NONE***
8. TRAFFIC CALMING SIGNS – ***WYTHALL NOW HAS SPEED WARNING SIGNS WHICH CAN BE MOVED AROUND THE PARISH***
9. PROMOTE MORE NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH GROUPS TO HELP WITH CRIME PREVENTION – ***MORE CO-ORDINATORS HAVE BEEN RECRUITED. ALSO SMART WATER IS ON SALE IN THE PARISH***
10. CCTV TO HELP REDUCE CRIME – ***INSTALLED AT DRAKES CROSS, STATION RD SHOPS AND WYTHALL STATION***
11. FULL TIME COMMUNITY SUPPORT OFFICER TO BE APPOINTED TO BE BASED AT WYTHALL AND SERVE WYTHALL EXCLUSIVELY – ***TWO APPOINTED AND SERVING***
12. GAIN BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF ROOT CAUSE OF YOUTH CRIME – ***DIVISIONARY MEASURES IN PLACE – THE MUGA AND THE YOUTH SHELTER AT WYTHALL PARK***
13. EXTEND THE ALCOHOL FREE ZONE – ***NO LONGER REQUIRED, AREAS RESTRICTIONS ALREADY IN PLACE ARE SUFFICIENT***

4. EMPLOY A COMMUNITY WORKER,A FULL TIME PERSON WHO CAN SUPPORT AND BUILD UP COMMUNITY LIFE – ***MORE RESEARCH***
5. CO-ORDINATE AND SUPPORT ALL KEY COMMUNITY FACILITIES PROVIDERS IN OUR AREA TO AVOID DUPLICATION AND TO USE ALL RESOURCES IN THE MOST EFFECTIVE WAY- ***MORE RESEARCH***
